Set gracefully on 5.12 picturesque acres, this nearly 8,000 SF masterpiece seamlessly blends pre-Civil War history with timeless luxury and architectural grandeur. Known as the "Logan Caldwell House" on the National Register of Historic Places, the home is rich in heritage -- having served as a hospital during the Civil War -- and has been beautifully preserved through the generations.

From its commanding proportions to its irreplaceable craftsmanship, every inch of the property reflects an era of elegance rarely seen today. A symmetrical circular drive makes for a dramatic entrance, while classic, stately blackboard fencing outlines the property with timeless Kentucky charm. A stunning drive-through portico and breezeway connect the main residence to the attached 2+-car garage. Above the garage, unfinished living quarters with roughed-in plumbing offer incredible potential for a private guest suite, caretaker's quarters, farmhand residence, studio, or additional flex space. Beyond the residence itself, the grounds unfold into a breathtaking private retreat complete with a romantic peony garden, a stone well house, a barn (horse stables), an additional 2-car garage/workshop, a potential accessory dwelling, and sweeping green space framed by mature trees and pastoral scenery.



Surrounded by hundreds of acres of privately-owned farmland, the property enjoys an unmatched sense of privacy, tranquility, and iconic Kentucky countryside views in every direction. The stunning rear wraparound porch captures picturesque panoramic vistas, offering the perfect setting for quiet mornings, elegant garden parties, and unforgettable sunsets. An outdoor entertaining area complete with a built-in grill and outdoor kitchen station further elevates the estate's exceptional lifestyle appeal, creating the perfect backdrop for al fresco dining. Inside, soaring ceilings, original hardwood floors, intricate millwork, grand staircases, and historic fireplaces create an atmosphere of sophistication and authenticity. Expansive formal and informal living spaces are filled with natural light and rich character. The beautifully remodeled kitchen serves as the heart of the home – thoughtfully designed with timeless finishes that honor the estate's historic character while offering elevated modern functionality. Custom cabinetry designed by renowned Barber Cabinetry Company is paired with granite countertops, a dedicated vegetable prep sink, and a stunning hand-carved wood range hood that anchors the space with warmth and craftsmanship. A cozy gas fireplace creates an inviting atmosphere, while dramatic walls of windows surround the kitchen and dining area, framing breathtaking views of the backyard landscape and filling the space with natural light throughout the day. Adding to the estate's extraordinary character is a rare stacked-stone basement that naturally maintains an approximately 62-degree temperature year-round – an ideal environment for a luxury wine cellar, bourbon collection, tasting room, or additional preservation space befitting a property of this caliber. Despite its peaceful estate setting, the property is conveniently located just 15 minutes from Downtown
